### EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

---

The minimum entry requirement is the completion of the overseas equivalent to the Higher School Certificate, completed at the end of year 12 in Australian secondary schools. Copies of academic transcripts should be included with the application form. An overseas student whose first language is not English should be able to speak and write English well. To be accepted for enrolment an overseas student should produce evidence of English language proficiency at a minimum level of IELTS 6.5 (general band score) or equivalent.

### OVERSEAS STUDENT HEALTH COVER

Australian Government regulations require all overseas students to have health insurance cover (OSHC). A student visa will not be granted by an Australian diplomatic mission until this is paid. Cost for fourteen months OSHC: approx \$560.00. Macleay will organise health cover on the student's behalf upon receipt of payment.

### COURSE CREDIT

---

Students can apply for course credit if they have suitable prior learning or experience. Where an application for course credit for a unit or subject is successful, this will result in the student being exempt from attending and completing that particular unit or subject in order to qualify for the qualification.
